## **IMPORTANT!!**

Assumption's Safety Policy – Adopted by the AGOC Parish Council on Tuesday, October 1, 2019

Due to concerns about safety and access, the council has recommended that a committee be formed to discuss safety with a welcoming attitude. In the meantime, the following policy is in place:

The door to the church will be unlocked at the start of Orthros. An usher will be present at the entrance to great parishioners and help non-members. At the start of liturgy there will be a minimum of two ushers present, one in the entrance and one in the narthex. Non-members are welcome to attend services. The upstairs bathroom is for primary use of the Sunday school students and teachers, priest, and altar boys. Visitors should be directed to the bathrooms in the Social Hall. The front door will be locked at the beginning of communion so the ushers can participate. If a parishioner arrives and finds the front door locked an usher will see you and will unlock the door from the usher station. We apologize for this inconvenience.

It is the policy of the church that there is no panhandling or solicitation on the premises, including the church building and parking lot. Anyone violating this policy can be asked to leave. Non-members are welcome to join parishioners for the social hour and meals after service but should not be given food during service.

Assumption should always remain a welcoming place for those who wish to pray and worship Christ.

Since the establishment of the biennial CMF Luncheon in 1989, \$3.59 million have been disbursed in grants to children's hospitals and health care organizations throughout the country. The types of grants awarded include:

- Innovative programs and services committed to improving and/or sustaining the health of children
- Financial assistance for the medical care of critically ill children whose families cannot afford the care
- Hospital equipment, programs and research which benefit all children with serious medical or surgical diagnoses

#### **Feed the Hungry**

The National Philoptochos Feed the Hungry program is a story of dedication, commitment, and success of our Philoptochos ladies. It began as part of National Philoptochos President Maria Logus' goal of "doing more hands on philanthropy, engaging all members of our community in our work."

The challenge has been set by National each year since 2015 and in 2018: Philoptochos workers and stewards not only surpassed our goal of feeding one million meals, but we served 1,339,651 meals nationwide. Our own Metropolis of Chicago chapters served 227,814 meals and 36 chapters from our Metropolis participated in the program.

Our National President Maria Logus, seeing the tremendous success of our previous goals, has set the new goal to reach 1.5 million meals from July 2018 until we meet at the next Biennial Convention in July of 2020.

We continue to engage in this program through the work done by our Philoptochos chapter and parishoners for shopping, cooking and serving for the shelter at Grace Episcopal Church and the River Food Pantry. Congratulations to all who participate in continuing the work locally and contributing overall to the Feed the Hungry program.
