So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built into it for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Natural disasters always bring troubling questions to mind: Why does God allow such terrible things to happen? Why doesn't He spare us from storms, earth-quakes and other catastrophic events?

Indeed, these are thought-provoking questions – questions that have no definitive answers. If we believe in an All-Loving God, we cannot accuse Him of CAUSING His children to suffer indiscriminately. Perhaps He allows natural disasters to occur in order to, as John Chrysostom once wrote, "...bring us back to salvation." Chrysostom also pointed out after a horrible earthquake in Antioch that we should be "...ashamed of our slowness in thanking God when He gives, and of our quickness in grumbling at Him when He takes away.

While surely capable of doing anything. God often chooses not to interfere in the natural course of events. While this may bring unexplained sadness and hardship to our lives, we must never forget that our Heavenly Father blesses us in many ways, not permitting affliction to overcome us. In the words of the longsuffering Job of the Old Testament: THE LORD TAKES AWAY. BLESSED BE THE NAME OF THE LORD.
